

DIGITAL PASSPORT ASSIGNMENT

Fluency with digital tools is essential in this course, and a great advantage in the career and college life that lies ahead of you. You will be expected to find information, communicate, and produce mathematics both by going online and using software.

On or before Friday, August 25, please do *all* of the following:

1. Visit the class website, <http://mathlore.net> and look at the various pages there: CM, Rules, Grades, Contact, Reference, and so on. Spend enough time familiarizing yourself with it, so that whenever it is referenced in class you won't be confused.
2. Class notices will be sent using the "Remind" system. Go to <https://www.remind.com/join/lhscm> and choose whether to be notified by cellphone text message, or email. We will be able to communicate through Remind however I will have no record of your phone number or email address, and you can change or delete them at any time. You may use your school email address (*if* you check it) or have it forwarded to a phone or email account that you *do* monitor. Another way to setup messaging to your phone, is by texting "@lhscm" to (234) 312-4653.
3. Go to <https://khanacademy.org/coaches> and create a login if you do not already have one. In the "Add a coach" field, enter the class code: "DBK3XK" – Khan Academy is used for various purposes, off & on, during this course.
4. Go to your Lakewood "@lakewoodcityschools.org" email address and send an email message to misterp@mathlore.net — the subject should be "DPA, CM –" and your name; the message should be, "Item 4 accomplished!" and anything else you might want to tell me.
5. Go to <https://classroom.google.com> and log in with your "@lakewoodcityschools.org" email and sign up for the Google Classroom "n6pjn3" – this is where detailed class assignments, notices, and many useful resources will be posted and archived. It is also the place where many class assignments *must* be turned in. You will see this assignment there. Assuming you have completed *all* five parts completely & correctly: indicate that you have completed the assignment appropriately.

Anyone who does not participate in our class online is unlikely to succeed. If you feel that you cannot participate online in these ways, you need to discuss this with Mr. Petto *immediately*.
